

Alignment to AHS Covid-19 Restrictions

To all ESC members,

Once again, the Edmonton Squash Club has been impacted by the Covid-19 pandemic. New restrictions were announced by AHS on Nov 12th a part of their 2-week “Circuit Breaker” plan. In compliance, the club was closed on Nov 13th. AHS subsequently released additional information clarifying the scope of their order.

The ESC Board met with the operations team on Nov 13th to review the situation. A detailed review of the AHS restrictions reveals that the ESC can remain open but squash activities are limited to *solo-play*, play within *direct* family cohorts, and off-court coaching. Under AHS’s “Circuit Breaker” restrictions, *play between members of a pod is not allowed* unless the individuals live in the same home.

During the next two weeks, club operating hours may be restricted as we require staff to be present at all times to ensure restrictions are followed. Court booking instructions will be circulated shortly and posted on our website.

The board is proactively managing the situation. We expect the restrictions to be lifted on Nov 27; however, we are considering actions to take if current restrictions are extended. We will be gathering information over the next 2 weeks to determine what is best for members and the overall stability of the club.
